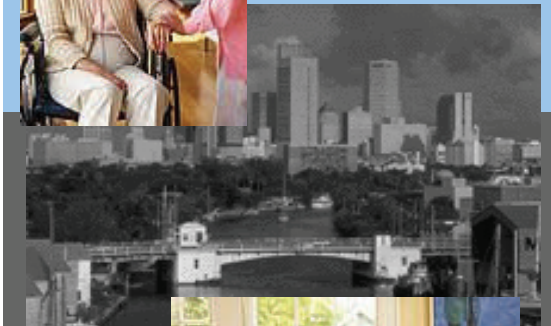

About our course

This course is designed for people who work in, or wish to work in, the Aged care Industry. This course allows participants access to advanced Aged Care policies and procedures.

The course also coaches participants in the legal requirements of Aged Care, including medical report storage and medication control.

This qualification addresses work primarily in residential facilities under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisation guidelines and service plans.

These workers:

1. Carry out activities to maintain personal care and/or other activities of living for people in an aged care setting;
2. Carry out activities related to an individualised plan;
3. Report directly to a supervisor and are not responsible for other workers.

The course will cover the following

- ✓ Providing care and support for older people;
- ✓ Communication methods for clients and staff;
- ✓ Understanding of the legislation related to aged care;
- ✓ Learning safety procedures for direct care work;

The course will cover the following (Continued)

- ✓ Dementia support and care;
- ✓ Cleaning and maintenance requirements;
- ✓ Providing personal care.

Other areas included:

- ✓ Occupational health and Safety;
- ✓ Learn to handle difficult behaviour;
- ✓ Care and maintenance of clients homes;
- ✓ Learn the legal requirements of information storage within the Aged Care industry.

Who should attend?

This course is targeted at everyone working in the Nursing or Community Services industries. Anyone who has contact with, or wishes to have contact with the elderly, or anyone working in a support role in the nursing or community services industry.
